How to Create a Bot in Telegram

Learn how to configure a Telegram bot to use with Telegram to Jira Connector.

The steps can be followed using either Telegram's mobile version or desktop version.

You can follow this video to help you see the steps in action.

Follow these steps:

1. Go to Telegram.

2. Search for BotFather, ensure it's the verified account.



3. Initiate a chat with the bot by typing in the command (/newbot)



4. Choose a name for your bot

(1)

This is not the name the users will be searching for, it's the name that will appear with the bot (example: Infosysta support).



5. Create a username for the bot, ending in 'bot'

Ó	It has to end in " bot " or "_ bot ".
	Good. Now let's choose a username for your bot. It must end in `bot`. Like this, for example: TetrisBot or tetris_bot. 11:54 AM

6. Once you're done, a congratulatory message will appear with an important message.

It will include your:

- Telegram bot username
- Telegram bot token

() Please take note of them as they will be essential in using setting your bot up with Telegram to Jira Connector.
