


# How to Install the Jira Extension in Chrome

## Overview


The GTJ Jira Extension in Chrome is an extension available for Gmail, Calendar, and Google Drive.

## Quick Steps


Steps #	Actions
1	Go to Chrome Web Store and install <b>Jira Extension in Chrome</b> through this <a href="#">link</a>
2	Click on the <b>Add to Chrome</b> button 
3	

After the extension is added, you can start seeing the **Jira Extension in Chrome** action button in your Google Apps as per the images below


From Chrome Browser




From Gmail
