


How to Install - Jira Extension in Chrome (Beta)

Overview

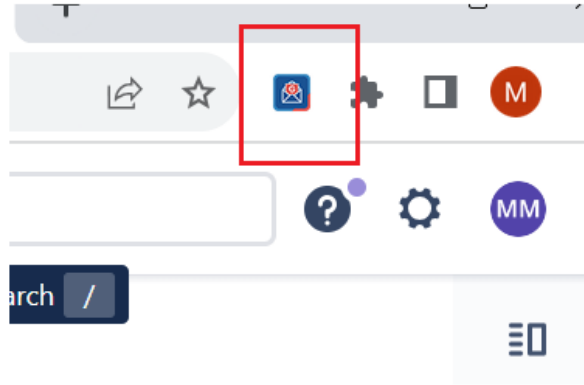
The GTJ Jira Connector Chrome extension is an extension available for Gmail, Calendar, and Google Drive.

Quick Steps

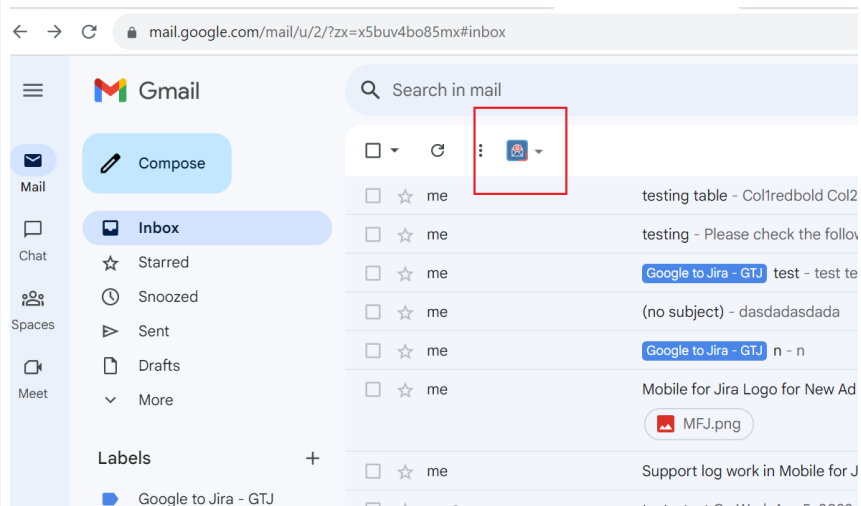
Steps #	Actions
1	Go to Chrome Web Store and install GTJ Jira Connector through this link




